make the cut

Using a mix of patterns—from large- to small-scale—cut wallpaper coordinates into blocks. A metal ruler or T square, craft knife, and self-healing mat will help you make even cuts. There's no need to measure, but make sure the edges are square.



mix it up

Paste large wallpaper sections on one wall, adjoining the edges; let dry. Next, paste smaller blocks over the base design, overlapping for a patchwork effect. Continue positioning blocks until you're satisfied with the look.
